Travel Statement (Inclusion in Student Handbook) (Approved by PLT):

Students are responsible for arranging and funding their own transportation to and from all assigned clinical sites, including those located off-campus or outside the immediate vicinity of the Medical Sciences Building (Scranton) and the School of Nursing (Lewistown). This includes travel for required clerkships, electives, intern or externships, and other clinical learning experiences.

Students should plan accordingly to ensure timely arrival at clinical sites and are expected to comply with all attendance and punctuality requirements. The College does not provide transportation or reimburse travel-related expenses unless explicitly stated in advance. A transportation budget is a component of the Cost of Attendance in the financial aid package in part to cover the cost of transportation to and from clinical site experiences. No site assignment adjustments are made due to transportation-related concerns. MD students may choose to go on away rotations or electives at other institutions at their own expense.

If a student has a disability and anticipates difficulty with transportation as a result of this, they are encouraged to contact the director of the Center for Learning Excellence at accessibility_services@geisinger.edu as early as possible. The CLE will work confidentially with students to determine reasonable accommodations in accordance with institutional policy and applicable laws.
